


Tools and Essentials

Post Protector Tube Stainless Steel

The post protector tube is inserted into a wood post where the cable enters/exits the post at an angle to keep the cable from biting into the wood.

Order **WC-CS-TUBE-4** for 1/8" dia. cable



CS TUBE Instructions

The POST PROTECTOR TUBE is inserted into the wood post where the cable enters/exits the post at an angle to keep the cable from biting into the wood when the cable is tensioned.

- 1.) After drilling your through-hole for the cable, drill a second hole at least 1" deep into the through-hole from the side where the cable will enter/exit the hole at an angle into which you will be installing the Post Protector Tube. If you are using 1/8" cable, the second hole diameter should be 1/4".
- 2.) Push the Post Protector Tube into the hole, with the flanged end on the outside of the post where the cable will enter/exit the post at an angle. You may need to tap it in with a hammer, being careful not to damage the flanged end. You are now ready to string your cable.
